## Callitriche stagnalis

Common name:

Pond water-starwort

## **Origin:**

Europe and North Africa

## Key features:

Plants are submersed with floating rosettes **Stems:** 4-12 inches (10-30 cm) long

**Leaves:** Floating leaves are opposite and oval or spoon shaped  $0.8 \times 0.1$ -0.3 inches (2 cm  $\times$  3-8 mm), submerged leaves are narrower and tend to be smaller

**Flowers:** Small with 2 small bracts at their base, flowers are close to each other at leaf bases for self pollination

**Fruits/Seeds:** Round 0.06-0.08 inches (1.5-2 mm) thick forming 4 mericarps that have thin winged margins

Reproduction: Cloning and seeds


## Easily confused species:
